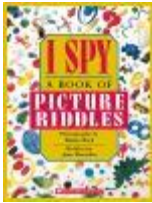


Fun Puzzle Books for Kids

Rhyming verses ask readers to find hidden objects in the photographs.



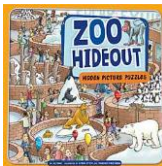
I Spy a Butterfly by Jean Marzollo (EASY READER MAR)

Illustrated scenes related to the zoo invite readers to find a list of objects hidden within them.

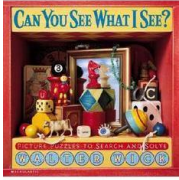


Mother Goose Picture Puzzles by Will Hillenbrand (J398.8 MOT)
Nursery rhymes are presented in the form of rebuses.



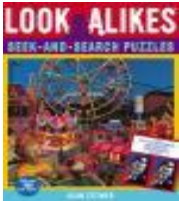

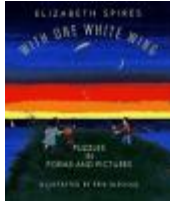

Riddle Road: Puzzles in Poems and Pictures by Elizabeth Spires (J811.54 SPI)

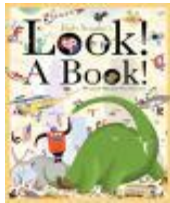
A collection of twenty-six original riddles with clues given in the illustrations.

Twenty-six original word and picture puzzles provide tantalizing verbal and pictorial hints to riddles whose answers range from food to flowers, bugs to toys.



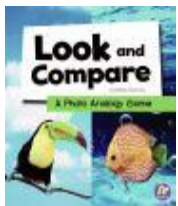
Look! A Book! by Bob Staake (E STA)

Easy-to-read, rhyming text invites the reader to search for items on a different theme on each page, while celebrating the wonder of a picture book.



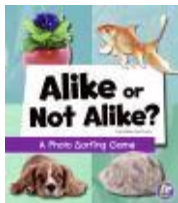
Fun and Games: A Spot-It Challenge by Jennifer Marks (J793.73 MAR)

Alike or Not Alike? A Photo Sorting Game by Kristen McCurry (J793.73 MCC)

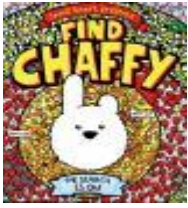

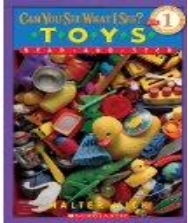
Children can read the simple text and use the picture clues to search twelve photos for 100 hidden objects!





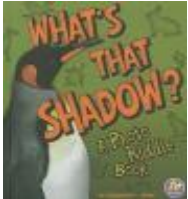
Find Chaffy by Jamie Smart (E SMA)
