#### CITIZENSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

#### You are eligible for US CITIZENSHIP if you:

- Have been a legal permanent resident for 4 years and 9 months and know Basic English.
- Have been a legal permanent resident for 2 years and 9 months, know basic English, And are married to an U.S. citizen.

#### English is NOT needed for US citizenship if:

- You have a disability and can obtain medical certification.
- You are 50 years old and have had your Resident Card for 20 years, or
- Are 55 years old and have had your Resident Card for 15 years.

### TO BE ABLE TO FILL OUT YOUR CITIZENSHIP APPLICATION PLEASE BRING TO THE WORKSHOP THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Two photos (frontal view) passport style.
- 2. Money order of \$675 payable to USCIS \$595 for those over 75 years, loans available at local banks.
- Your resident card, social security card and your driver's license or State ID (originals and 2 copies).
- 4. Dates of all trips outside the U.S. since you received your legal residence card and dates of departure and return.
- 5. A list of all your addresses where you have lived for the past 5 years.
- 6. The name and addresses of your employers for the last 5 years.
- 7. Your spouse's name, date of birth, social security number and resident number if she is a resident or the date and place of naturalization if she is a US citizen.
- 8. Date of current marriage.
- 9. If you or your spouse were married before bring all divorce decrees.
- 10. The names of <u>all</u> your children, date of birth and legal residence card number (if they are legal residents) and their addresses if not living with you.
- 11. If you have had traffic or criminal charges bring your certified court dispositions. You may obtain them where you went to court.
- 12. For males: Bring your Selective Service number and registration date. If you don't know it, call (847) 688-6888 or go to <a href="https://www.sss.gov">www.sss.gov</a>
- 13. Donation to cover Shipping and Handling \$15.00.

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
