- You can be out of the country as long as you wish.
- > You have more retirement benefits.
- Your children under 18 gain citizenship with you.
- ➤ The application process for your parents, spouse and children under 21 is faster.
- > You can petition for your sibling of any age.
- > Your children can apply for more scholarships to pay for college or university.

CITIZENSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

You are eligible for US CITIZENSHIP if you:

- ➤ Have been a legal permanent resident for 4 years and 9 months and know Basic English.
- ➤ Have been a legal permanent resident for 2 years and 9 months, know basic English, and are married to an U.S. citizen.

English is NOT needed for US citizenship if:

- You have a disability and can obtain medical certification.
- You are 50 years old and have had your Resident Card for 20 years, or
- Are 55 years old and have had your Resident Card for 15 years.

TO BE ABLE TO FILL OUT YOUR CITIZENSHIP APPLICATION PLEASE BRING TO THE WORKSHOP THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Money order of \$675 payable to USCIS \$595 for those over 75 years, (loans available with Associated Bank) If you are disabled, unemployed or receiving public aid the fee may be waived). Ask at the workshop.
- 2. Two photos (frontal view) passport style.
- 3. You're resident card, social security card and your driver's license or State ID (originals and 2 copies).
- 4. Dates of all travels outside the U.S. since you received your legal residence card and number of days absent.
- 5. A list of all your addresses where you have lived for the past 5 years.
- 6. The name and addresses of your employers for the last 5 years.
- 7. Your spouse's name, date of birth, social security and card number if she is a resident or the date and place of naturalization if she is a US citizen.
- 8. Date of current marriage.
- 9. If you or your spouse were married before bring all divorce decrees.
- 10. The names of <u>all your children</u>, date of birth and legal residence card numbers (if they are legal residents) and their addresses if not living with you.
- 11. If you have had courts bring your certified court dispositions. You may obtain them where you went to court.
- 12. For males: Bring your Selective Service number and registration date. If you don't know it call (847) 688-6888 or go to www.sss.gov
